NOTICE OF THE PREPARATION OF THE CORK CITY DRAFT LOCAL AUTHORITY CLIMATE ACTION PLAN 2024-2029

Notice is hereby given that Cork City Council has, pursuant to Section 14B(2)(a) of the Climate Action and Low Carbon Development Act 2015 to 2021, prepared a Draft Local Authority Climate Action Plan 2024-2029. The Draft Plan is accompanied by an Environmental Report, prepared in accordance with the European Communities (Environmental Assessment of Certain Plans and Programmes) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 435 of 2004 as amended by S.I. 200 of 2011) for Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA), and Appropriate Assessment (AA) Natura Impact Report, pursuant to Article 6 of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC.

The Draft Plan sets out the actions that will help deliver on the national climate obligations and the Government's overall National Climate Objective, which seeks to 'pursue and achieve, by no later than the end of 2050, the transition to a climate resilient, biodiversity rich, environmentally sustainable and climate neutral economy'.
