Naming of new pedestrian/cycle bridge linking Proby's Quay/Crosses Green to South Main Street via the former Beamish & Crawford Brewery site.

Background

The new bridge is scheduled to open to the public in early 2026. The bridge will provide a safe and convenient connection between the City Centre and communities to the west including key destinations such as St Fin Barre's Cathedral, UCC Etc.

The 25-metre long steel arch bridge, manufactured off-site, was installed in 2025. Final works to enhance the surrounding public realm are now underway, including the development of a dedicated pedestrian and cyclist route through the former brewery site, linking directly to South Main Street. This new connection will provide a safe and convenient route for both residents and visitors, making this historic quarter of Cork City more accessible and inviting for all.
