NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE CORK CITY COUNCIL BYE-LAWS

CORK CITY COUNCIL PARKING BYE-LAWS 2022

Take notice that Cork City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, (No. 7 of 1994), proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws in relation to the control and regulation of the parking of vehicles on public roads in the City of Cork, in the area defined in Bye-Laws. The proposed Bye Laws include provisions as to the payment of fees, the amount of fees and the manner and proof of payment in respect of the parking of vehicles.

A copy of the draft Cork City Council Parking Bye-Laws 2022 will be available for public inspection Monday to Friday (inclusive) during the period of one month commencing Friday 1st April to Tuesday 3rd May 2022 and between the hours of 10am and 4pm at the Reception Desk, City Hall, Anglesea Street, Cork. Accordingly, they will be included in the minutes of that meeting and may appear in the public domain.
